Tombigbee Fiber looks to bring high-speed internet service to portion of PEPA service area.

Pontotoc, MS, November 22, 2021 ---Today, Pontotoc Electric Power Association (PEPA) announced that Tombigbee Fiber, LLC plans to build fiber in the eastern portion of Pontotoc County, Mississippi, and the southeastern portion of Union County, Mississippi, offering gigabit speeds and unrivaled customer service and responsiveness.

Tombigbee Electric officials stated, "The proposed project is expected to commence construction, absent of any material changes occurring in the interim, immediately following the conclusion of the build to Tombigbee Electric members, in 2023."

Pontotoc Electric officials indicated PEPA would be working in conjunction with Tombigbee Fiber beginning with the eastern portion of Pontotoc and Union Counties, with Highway 15 being the boundary point at this time.
